What is Lexia?

Online Literacy programme to support children with reading and phonics.

It allows teachers to monitor progress and identify areas that children need support with.

Individualised to the needs of each child.

Children's Experience

Lexía Reading Core5° covers the six areas of reading instruction. This begins with oral language and listening comprehension, building to reading comprehension. Children can complete sections in any order but need to complete all sections before moving onto the next level.

Key message!

- It is important that if children get stuck, they attempt questions independently. This is the only way the programme can personalise the questions for them and send the information to their class teacher.
- Parents, please only help them with the technical aspects such as where to click with the mouse and how to navigate the program.
- The children need to be able to continue using the programme in school so we need the level to be accurate to support them.
- The program will aid them and give them 'Guided Practice' and then 'Direct Instruction' if they are struggling and this will be followed up in school with Lexia lessons.
