
Key Stage 1 — Spring 2nd - Frozen Regions



SCIENCE

Session 1

L.O: I am learning to identifying and comparing the suitability of a variety of materials for particular uses.

We will be looking at the question "which material is most suitable for making teddy a coat?". Teddy needs a coat to go on his trip to Antarctica. We will be filling out a table with our predictions.

L.O: I am learning to identifying and comparing the suitability of a variety of materials for particular uses.


We will be writing up the results from our test and choosing a suitable material to make Teddy a coat.



Session 4

We will be making a sculpture out of a range of materials and looking at how the materials we use change shape.



Session 5

L.O: I am learning to identifying and comparing the suitability of a variety of materials for particular uses.

We will be reading the poem 'A Woolly Saucepan' by Michael Rosen. We will be making up our own versions of the poem using all of our science knowledge.



GEOGRAPHY

Session 1

L.O: I am learning to identify how weather changes through the seasons.

We will be exploring the weather associated with the seasons in the United Kingdom. We will be exploring different pictures and using them to help us identify how the weather changes throughout the seasons.



Session 4

L.O: I am learning to understand what the weather is like in Antarctica.

L.O: I am learning to locate the continents, Equator, North and South Pole on a map.

We will be locating Antarctica on the map. We will be looking at the continents and labelling the Equator and the North and South poles.



Session 5

L.O: I am learning to understand the similarities and differences between Antarctica and the United Kingdom.

We will be comparing the UK's weather to Antarctica. We will be writing postcards from our trip to Antarctica.
